The importance of the role of parents in achieving the desired outcome of the programs in general and courses in specific is given priority. The institution has many mechanisms where in the parent and the teachers are involved in framing the outcome of the students. At the beginning of the program, the institution conducts the orientation programs for the students where in the parents of every student are invited. As a part of the orientation program, the students and parents are briefed about the programs, the courses involved in it, the duties and responsibilities of the students and parents, discipline of the programs to be followed and the pattern of the academics. In the same program, the students and parents are informed about the mentor allotted to the students. The details of the students and the parents are noted down by the mentor. Later, periodically, the mentor interacts with the parents regarding the academic performance and the discipline of the students in the institution. Every mentor maintains the log book which is duly signed by the student regarding the meeting conducted by the mentor and also by the mentee.

The head of the institution reviews these log books periodically.
